CANCELLATION POLICY: ACRM is a non-profit organization. Registrants wishing to cancel their existing registration to receive a refund must submit a written request to sbarrah@ACRM.org. A cancellation fee of \$249 USD will be charged on all cancellations received on or before 31 August 2017. The balance of registration paid will be refunded. On or after 1 September, 2017, a fee of \$249 USD or 50 percent of registration paid, whichever is greater, will be charged and any balance refunded. If registration amount paid is less than or equal to \$249, no refund will be given. No refunds will be made on or after 1 October 2017. Those who registered as non-members retain their 6-month ACRM membership.
