After 31 August 2017, a fee of \$199 USD or 50 percent of registration paid, whichever is greater, will be charged and any balance refunded. If registration amount paid is less than or equal to \$199, no refund will be given. No refunds will be made after 1 October 2017. Those who registered as non-members retain their 6-month ACRM membership.
