ABOUT the FELLOWSHIP

Selected fellows will receive a one-year ACRM membership and **\$1000** stipend to cover travel expenses to Dallas, TX. **The fellowship includes:**

- In-person participation in the CIRM Workshop on 31 October from 7:30 AM - 2:30 PM;
- PAID registration to attend the in-person ACRM 101st Annual Conference in Dallas, TX, from 31 October to 03 November 2024;
- Networking in the monthly virtual ACRM CIRM-NG group meetings.
- Selected fellows are required to submit a poster for the CIRM Fellow Poster Award Session during the annual meeting. Two posters will be selected for monetary awards (\$300 each).

Held in conjunction with the 2024 ACRM Annual Scientific Meeting, this workshop will provide research training, mentoring, and networking for emerging scholars interested in the field.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Curriculum vitae.
- A short personal statement (500 words or fewer) describing your research interests and commitment to the field of rehabilitation medicine.
- A description of how the R13 CIRM Fellowship will impact your scientific career development.
- A diversity, equality, and inclusion statement vision for the rehabilitation sciences.
- A letter of recommendation from a supervisor, or mentor.
