

ACRM Poster Award Review Criteria

Title

- Title is well related to article contents

Aims/Objectives/Hypotheses

- Problem/gap and significance are clearly stated
- Adequate review of relevant literature for reader to understand
- Research question (or) statement of purpose (and/or) hypotheses are clearly articulated

Procedures

- Appropriate research design for problem being examined
- Sample is adequately described, including demographics and study criteria if applicable
- Data collection methods including instruments and apparatus are clearly described
- Appropriate data analysis methods are described and conducted

Results

- Results are presented clearly
- Tables and figures are clear and effective to illuminate findings

Discussion/Conclusions

- Conclusions are clearly stated
- Conclusions are relevant to the problem (as outlined in the aims/objectives/hypotheses)

Significance for Rehabilitation

- Study is clearly innovative
- Study is likely to have high impact on rehabilitation science

Form and Style

- Poster is clearly and logically presented
- Poster content is free from biases
