### TERMS & CONDITIONS

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** All registration cancellations and refund requests must be submitted in writing to sbarrah@ACRM.org. A cancellation fee of \$195 USD will be charged on all cancellations received before 31 August 2014. The balance of registration paid will be refunded. After 31 August 2014, a fee of \$195 USD or 50 percent of registration paid, whichever is greater, will be charged and any balance refunded. If registration amount paid is less than \$195, no refund will be given. No refunds will be made after 213 SEPTember 2014. Those who registered as non-members retain their 6-month ACRM membership, including a subscription to the ACRM journal, *Archives of Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation*. ACRM members who cancel will receive a 6-month extension to their membership.

**SUBSTITUTIONS / TRANSFERS:** The original registrant will be charged a substitution fee of \$195 USD and receive a 6-month ACRM membership.

**FORCE MAJEURE** In the event of a full or partial cancellation of the ACRM Annual Conference due to natural disaster or other force beyond the control of ACRM, ACRM will make a pro rata distribution of cancellation insurance proceeds applicable to registration refunds.
