Edelle Field-Fote, PT, PhD, FAPTA is the director of spinal cord injury research and the Hulse Laboratory at the Shepherd Center. The efforts of her laboratory are directed at investigating the role of rehabilitation in fostering activity-driven neuroplasticity, and developing advanced rehabilitation strategies to improve function in people with spinal cord injury using combined interventions to promote adaptive neural reorganization. She is the editor/author of the textbook *Spinal Cord Injury Rehabilitation* (FA Davis Publishers, 2009), and her studies have been published in an array of peer-reviewed journals ranging from *Physical Therapy*, to the *Journal of Neuroscience*, and the *Journal of Applied Biomechanics*. She currently serves as Editor-in-Chief of the *Journal of Neurologic Physical Therapy* and as Executive Editor of the *Journal of Motor Behavior*. Her research has been funded by NIH since 1997, with additional funding from NIDRR and the Craig H. Nielsen Foundation.
