Dr. Wethe is a clinical neuropsychologist with more than a decade of experience in the assessment and rehabilitation of adults and children with acquired brain injury and other neurological conditions. She is the primary neuropsychologist for the Mayo Clinic Sports Neurology and Comprehensive Concussion Program. Prior to joining Mayo Clinic in 2013, Dr. Wethe oversaw and coordinated the rehabilitation of patients with acquired brain injury at Hook Rehabilitation's comprehensive adult outpatient neurorehabilitation program at Community Health Network in Indianapolis, Indiana. Prior to that she was at Barrow Neurological Institute / St. Joseph's Hospital and Medical Center in Phoenix, Arizona, where she was an associate professor of neuropsychology and Associate Director of the Children's Center for Neuropsychological Rehabilitation. In addition to clinical work, Dr. Wethe's responsibilities at Barrow included program development, outcome research, staff education, and supervision of post-doctoral residents. She was instrumental in the development of the interdisciplinary B.R.A.I.N.S. (concussion) Clinic and the Children's Center for Neuropsychological Rehabilitation. Dr. Wethe has been involved in a number of collaborative research projects. Her research interests include clinical assessment and test validation, factors that influence concussion and rehabilitation outcome, chronic traumatic encephalopathy, and neurobehavioral functioning in hypothalamic hamartoma. Dr. Wethe is an active member of many professional organizations and regularly presents at national and international conferences.

Dr. Wethe completed a Bachelor of Arts degree in psychology at Purdue University. She went on to complete Master of Science and Doctor of Philosophy degrees in clinical psychology, also at Purdue University. She trained as a pre-doctoral fellow at Wishard Health Services-Indiana University Medical Center; completed a neuropsychology internship at University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston; and completed a post-doctoral fellowship in neuropsychology and rehabilitation at Barrow Neurological Institute / St. Joseph's Hospital and Medical Center.
